



TWSC Black Weir Slalom Course Rules

These 8 (eight) requirements are "not negotiable" in relation to the use of our club's Black weir slalom course, please ensure these requirements are met on all occasions.

- TWSC Slalom Course must only be used by TWSC members only.
- Slalom Course bookings need to be approved by the appointed Committee member (Kurt).
- TWSC signage must be in the river while training is in progress.
- Only Tournament style ski boats^{#1} to be used in this area. #1
- This area of the river is for Tournament training only Slalom / Trick / Barefoot.
- Any damage caused while using the slalom course needs to be reported to the ski club president or a committee member ASAP.
- Members must have completed an induction prior to booking the course.
- Exclusions apply to come and try days, familiarisation and competitions.
- Club members will observe for public watercraft entering within the training course. Driver to stop training session until public watercraft is out of training course.

If you have any questions regarding these rules, please contact the club president.

Note:

#1. A tournament style ski boat must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Be of fibreglass or composite construction.
- ✓ Have a centre mount engine with direct coupled prop shaft via a F-N-R gearbox.
- ✓ Have GPS speed controller (i.e. either Zero-off or Perfect Pass).
- ✓ Have a centre ski pole.
- ✓ Have a full width duck board.
- ✓ Be capable of towing all three water ski events. Slalom, Jump & Trick in a sanctioned event such as an AWWF tournament.

Any breaches of the rules will be reviewed by the committee. The committee will have full authority to deny access to anyone not complying with these rules.

Failure to agree to these club rules will result in refusal of membership or membership renewal.
